






World Heritage Registered Area



16 Tsugaru Toge (Tsugaru Pass)



Located on the border with Ajigasawa Town. From here, sweeping views of the Shirakami-Sanchi mountains spread out below.



4 Taihaku Hot Springs

A natural hot spring near apple orchards, known for its silky-smooth waters. Open-air baths are available from May to October.



2 Shirakami Sanchi Visitor Center



Learn about the beech forests of Shirakami-Sanchi and their ecosystem through exhibits and a visual experience hall.

5 BUNACO Nishimeya Factory / BUNACO CAFÉ

“BUNACO” is a unique woodcraft born from making effective use of beech resources. Offers hands-on workshops as well as an attached café.



7 Takanosu Nature Trail/Iwaya Kanzeon

A rare cave temple across the river from Takanosu, reached by a narrow path. Mysterious and spiritual atmosphere.



3 Buna-no-sato Shirakami-kan



Lodging with traditional Japanese-style rooms featuring the warmth of wood. Facilities include the natural hot spring bath, “Shirakami no Yu” which also features a sauna, plus a smaller bath reserved for hotel guests.

15 Shirakami Izanai Tree



A 300-year-old beech tree, chosen as the symbolic successor to the “Mother Tree.” About 60 m (a 2-minute walk) from the Buna-kyoboku Trail entrance. Admire its tall, graceful form.

Estimated age: 300 years
Height: approx. 27 m
Trunk circumference: 4.05 m
Diameter at breast height: 1.29 m

8 Green Park Mori-no-Izumi



Condominium-style lodging with kitchens and refrigerators in each room, perfect for self-catering and long stays. “Muraichi no Yu” is a natural hot spring.

1 Rest stop “Tsugaru Shirakami”



Beech Nishimeya (Farmers' Market/Restaurant)

The hub for sightseeing in Nishimeya. It offers a wide selection of souvenirs, and the restaurant serves the local specialty, “Tsugaru Dam Curry.”

14 Annon Gorge Route




A trail along the Annon River leading to the 3rd, 2nd, and 1st Annon Falls in that order. The path to the 2nd fall is partially maintained; the route to the 1st fall is unmaintained.

12 Aqua Green Village ANMON



At the entrance of the Shirakami-Sanchi, this site features a central building with a large public bath, cottages, and drive-in campsites with kitchens and toilets.

10 Tsugaru Dam Park



A 33-meter-high waterfall cascading like white silk. In winter, it freezes and is beautifully illuminated, creating a magical scene.

Walk across the dam for sweeping views of Lake Tsugaru-Shirakami. Don't miss the life-size dam card photo frame. A dam learning room is located on the first floor.

13 World Heritage Beech Forests Trail



A light trekking course within the World Heritage area. From the fresh greenery and lingering snow of spring to the golden hues of autumn, enjoy observing the beech trees and forest plants.

11 Amphibious Bus “Nishimeya Dam Lake Tour”



The first amphibious bus in Tohoku! Departing from the roadside station, it drives through the village before splashing into Lake Tsugaru-Shirakami. You might get wet!
